



The goal of Onstage Dance Centers' Code of Conduct is to help students and teachers create an environment that is conducive to teaching and learning. Students learn better in a secure, positive, and non-disruptive learning environment which is essential to our success. We appreciate your commitment to these principals.

Attendance

Attendance is very important to ensure each student's progress. Students who miss two consecutive classes without prior arrangement may be dismissed from the class and/or from upcoming performances.

Drop-off/Pick-up

We do not provide childcare. If you are late, you assume full responsibility for your child's welfare. After class please have your child wait inside the studio. Students should be dropped off no earlier than 20 minutes and picked up within 5 minutes of class dismissal. Students dropped off too early or picked up after the studio has closed may be charged a childcare fee.

We advise parents of younger dancers (3-5) to stay at the studio while their child is in class.

Lobby Etiquette

Parents must supervise younger siblings not attending class. Absolutely no loud or disruptive behavior will be tolerated. Parents and visitors are not permitted to enter any classroom. Food is not permitted in our lobby areas. Please consume all food in our kitchen area. Negative attitudes and/or volatile scenes are not tolerated at Onstage Dance Center. We reserve the right to refuse services to any person who does not act in accordance with the policies and decisions set forth.

Food and Drinks

No food, gum, or drink is allowed in the dance rooms or lobby areas. Only bottled water is allowed in the dance rooms.

Level Placement

Promotions to higher class levels will be decided by the teacher. Dance is an art form that requires time and perseverance. During time of success and discouragement, parental support is vital. Teachers will use discretion and confidentiality when communicating your child's progress. Teachers determine class placement and your support in their decisions and selection of class placement is necessary. Please do not compare your child to other dancers.

Hands-On Instruction

Dance education requires verbal and hands-on instruction. Instructors will regularly critique dancers by touching their arms, legs, feet, hips, back, and head to correct their positioning.

Illness

If your child/ren are sick DO NOT send them to class. If they are exhibiting any fever, or any type of infection, including but not limited to conjunctivitis, cold, pneumonia, warts, hand-foot-and-mouth disease or symptoms of COVID-19, cough, shortness of breath/difficulty breathing, chills, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, keep them home. **Onstage Dance Center employees have followed CDC guidelines for COVID-19 awareness and training. Onstage Dance Center has implemented procedures for pre-screening anyone entering its facilities to ensure the safety of our employees and clientele.**

Responsibility & Risks

Please be aware that dance, like any physical activity, comes with the risk of potential injury. Registration includes understanding and accepting the risk and assuming responsibility for the safety of your child. We will take every step possible to provide a safe environment for you and your dancer.

Late Arrival

To help avoid injury, students should arrive to class on time for a proper warm-up. If a student is more than 15-minutes late, the dancer may be asked to observe. If you are going to be late, please call the studio and ask the teacher to be notified.

Photography & Videography

All choreography taught by Onstage Dance Center is property of the studio. Photography and/or videography taken during class or performance should only be of your dancer.

By registering at Onstage Dance Center, you agree that you and/or your child's image may be used in print and online for advertising and promotional purposes.

Safety

Unsupervised young children may not walk across the street or parking lot. Playing in the parking lot is prohibited. Please monitor your young children around doors and stairways.

Correspondence

Please check your email and in-studio information boards to receive the most up-to-date information. Teachers will also deliver important information at the end of class, so please be available the last 5 minutes of your student's class to attend these informative meetings.

Lost and Found

The studio is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Please label your dancer's shoes and belongings and check their dance bag regularly. Lost-and-found will be thrown out if not claimed within 24-hours of being left at the studio.
